

Notice to the Public:

Notifying the Public of Rights under Title VI

Harbor House of Louisville, Inc. operates its programs and services without regard to race, color, or national origin, in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.

If you believe you have been discriminated against on the basis of race, color, or national origin by Harbor House of Louisville, Inc., you may file a Title VI complaint by completing, signing, and submitting the agency's Title VI Complaint Form.

How to file a Title VI complaint with Harbor House of Louisville, Inc.

1. A Complaint Form may be obtained from the Harbor House of Louisville, Inc. website: www.hhlou.org, or in person from the Harbor House of Louisville, Inc. office at 2231 Lower Hunters Trace, Louisville, KY 40216
2. In addition to the complaint process at Harbor House of Louisville, Inc. complaints may be filed directly with the Federal Transit Administration, Office of Civil Rights, Region 4, 230 Peachtree Street, NW, Suite 1400, Atlanta, GA 30303 Phone: 404-865-5600
3. Complaints must be filed within 180 days following the date of the alleged discriminatory occurrence and should contain as much detailed information about the alleged discrimination as possible.
4. The form must be signed and dated, and include your contact information.
